- **Pumpkin string lights:** Take some ping pong balls, paint them orange, and draw jack-o'-lantern faces on them. Next, attach them to string lights for a festive glow and hang them wherever you please.
- **Poisonous potion bottles:** Give your old perfume, pill, and condiment bottles a glow up! Paint over them, adorn them with plastic gems, and label them with creative potion names for a memorable centerpiece.
